Third Grade Students are Coding!

..... And they are loving it. Last week, Mrs. Buttman's class began coding lessons in the classroom and in the computer lab. Coding is a language that you type into the computer to perform tasks. The "unplugged" activities are taught in the classroom and then the students apply those concepts online to drag and drop the commands necessary to get the angry bird to the pig. These lessons are free on Code.org, a non-profit company dedicated to expanding computer science access to all kids. It is supported by generous donations from individuals and companies such as Microsoft, Facebook, Google, etc.

In 2013, Code.org was launched by Hadi and Ali Partovi with a video promoting teaching computer science in schools. The video became #1 for the day and 15,000 schools reached out to them for help. Today tens of millions are inspired, learning, and loving the "Hour of Code". The founders ask that teachers provide an hour a week for students to experience computer science. As Hadi Partovi said, "Everyone understands that technology is changing the world and the Hour of Code gives students the opportunity to learn that coding a program is easy and anyone can do it." Our third graders loved it and can't wait for more.

In last week's Hour of Code they were problem solving, collaborating, using creativity, and totally engaged. The students had to think logically and work patiently to allow themselves to solve problems. Ask any third grader, coding is awesome!
