## **2nd Grade Class**

Through PLTW and the Changing Earth unit, the second grade class predicted Earth and tested different types of erosion to see which one would produce the most damage to land. The types of erosion tested were wind, earthquake, ice, and water. The students performed the tests and used a graduated cylinder to measure how much land was lost after each test. They recorded and compared the results. Each student had a job and activity to perform in the project.
