Shelter Box: We will have the contents of a Shelter Box set up in the entryway of school on Tuesday, March 7, from 9:00-3:00. A Shelter Box is a tent-like structure for 10 people, containing a wood-burning stove, cooking utensils, and tools, among other items. The complete box with contents has been distributed to over 125,000 people who have been struck by disasters of floods, hurricanes, earthquakes and fires, mainly in other countries. While these boxes are fairly new, they have helped people live for as long as 5 years. The contents are somewhat varied, depending on the climate. The Rotary Club is sponsoring the Shelter Boxes and wants to make the public aware of how they can be life-saving for people in need. I thought it would be good to share this with our students and also make the display public. Anyone is welcome to come see this on Tuesday, March 7.

Science Fair: The 7th and 8th grade students of Mrs. Armentrout will have their Science Fair projects on display in the hallway of school on Wednesday, March 8. They will be judged Wednesday morning. The 5th and 6th grade students will have their science projects set up in the gym that same day so students in other classrooms can participate in them and learn about the scientific process.
