News from the 7th & 8th grade



The 7th and grade students in Mrs. Armentrout's class are working in collaborative groups on a story writing process using "story cubes". The students had three sessions to collaborate over a span of three days. In addition to writing a story, they were asked to illustrate a scene from their story. Each group will present their story and illustration to the "general audience" of our classroom. This activity, among other Diocesan standards, requires students to accomplish the following Diocesan standards in ELA (English Language Arts): *demonstrate command of the conventions of standard English capitalization, punctuation, and spelling when writing; *use knowledge of language and its conventions when writing, speaking, reading, or listening to choose language that precisely and concisely reflects meaning; *engage effectively in a range of collaborative discussion with partners, building on others' ideas and expressing their own clearly; *to produce clear and coherent writing in which the development, organization, and style are appropriate to task, purpose, and audience; and for students to gain practice in speaking fluently, appropriately present their work to a specific audience.
