We have been making preparations for our upcoming **'testing week'**. Our students in grades 3-8 will be taking a standardized test this next week in Math, Science, Social Studies and Language Arts/Reading. The results help determine how students are performing on nationwide standards. They also help teachers identify a student's strengths and areas that may need additional emphasis. Grades 4 and 7 will take an additional short test the following week, called the CogAT, which measures verbal and nonverbal skills.

Lent is a time of extra prayer and reflection, and we are incorporating that into our school day. Among other learning activities relating to Lent, the religion teachers have taken students from their class to the church to participate in the *Stations of the Cross*. We also said a *school rosary*, with the special intention for the loss of one of our school parents. Students have *made cards* for people and some have completed *art projects* with scenes from the Passion. On Wednesday, April 16, teachers are planning a *'Student Retreat'* to be included in their day. All of these activities are aimed at bringing students closer to God, reminding them of Jesus' love and joy of the Resurrection, and developing more habits of prayer.

Test Taking Tips for Parents

***Encourage your child to do their best, so they can show what they know. They might not know everything, but they do know a lot so give it their best effort. Help them feel confident!**

***Keep a positive attitude about the tests and help your child to do the same.**

***Support healthy habits. Sleep and nutrition can have a huge impact on your child's ability to focus and retain information, It's especially important to make sure that your child gets a good night's sleep, starts the day with a filling breakfast and goes to school with a water bottle to help stay hydrated (avoid heavy foods that may make him/her groggy and avoid high sugar food that may make him/her hyperactive).**
