Bishop Hogan is blessed to be eligible to receive the **MoScholars** funds (Through the **Bright Future Fund**) for the 2025-2026 school year. MOScholars is a state-funded scholarship program, designed to support families who wish to enroll their children in private schools, including our Catholic school community. These scholarships are available for qualifying students based on eligibility criteria. Our upcoming kindergarten or first grade students are eligible to apply. We have sent information out to the parents to complete an application, so we hope to have several that qualify.

The state of Missouri allows any individual or business to **re-direct up to half of what they owe in state income tax** to an education fund. **The Bright Futures Fund** provides Catholic school scholarships to qualifying families, funded with tax dollars you have to pay anyway. 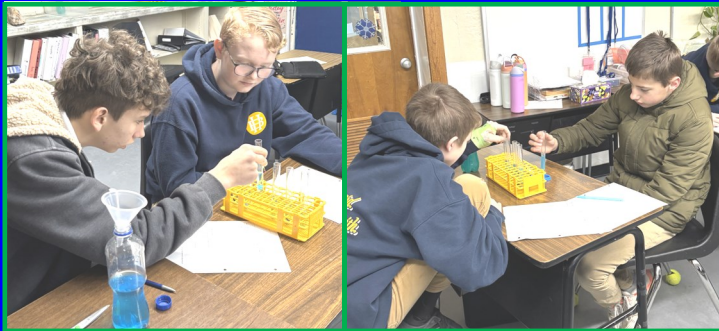

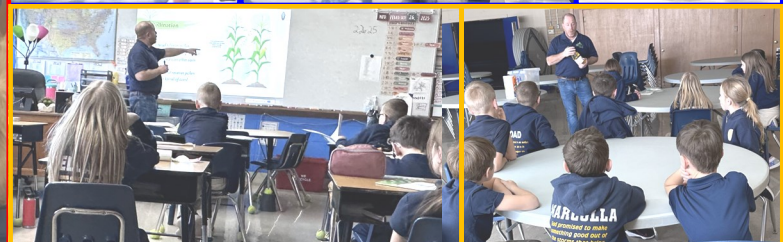
Ms. Martin's 4th grade class are learning about classifications. They are working on different ways to sort beans.
